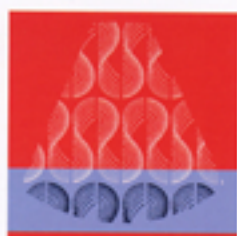
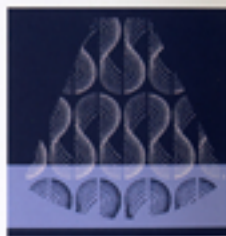


joanna kinnersly-taylor wavelengths

Northern Print Studio commissioned Joanna Kinnersly-Taylor to make new textile work for temporary, public display on Fish Quay. Joanna is a textile artist with a growing reputation in the UK and beyond. She works in Glasgow and is a member of the 62 Group.

Joanna produced a series of works that included four banners. 'Shawl Currents' were hand-printed woolen 'skirts' based on the traditional clothing worn by fishwives. These were hung from the balconies of the Fisherman's Mission. Opposite these was a long, digitally printed banner, reminiscent of sails. The pattern was drawn from trawlers and sea currents.

To compliment these installations, Joanna designed and printed aprons and wellingtons for the workers of Fish Quay.
